Here are some tips and answers to our most frequently asked questions.

What are the spiritual topics covered?

The theme of “MASTERPIECE” is choosing to see yourself the way God sees you - His carefully designed work of art, created with purpose and beauty. On Day One, kids will learn that God is The Master Artist who created everything and that nothing is too hard for Him. On Day Two, they’ll discover that they are God’s masterpiece, made in His image, uniquely designed, and deeply loved. Day Three shows that we are Designed With A Purpose - made to be close to God, but how sin broke that relationship and how Jesus restored it. On Day Four, kids will see The Big Picture that God has a plan for their lives, even when things don’t make sense, and they can trust Him completely. Finally, on Day Five, children will be challenged to Paint The World with God’s love, taking His message of hope and sharing it everywhere they go.

Where can I get the music?

All songs are provided in the Big Event Experience (in the Music folder) and on all streaming platforms.

Do you offer additional “MASTERPIECE” themed products?

We provide the “MASTERPIECE” logo in a variety of file sizes and formats to allow you to make your own shirts, posters, banners, etc. Feel free to use it in any way that benefits your event or ministry.

What should I do if my event is less than five days?

High Voltage Kids Curriculum is highly customizable. You are welcome to pick and choose which lessons you would like to use. However, the videos in our lessons do make reference to each other.

What should I name my teams?

We suggest naming your teams after famous artists, colors, or creative art terms that match the “Masterpiece” theme. We have provided some examples:

Sample Schedule

This schedule is based on a three-hour experience. It is flexible and able to be redesigned to accommodate your facilities and schedule.

The “Large Group Experience”

The first page of each lesson includes a lesson plan for the service. On the second page of each lesson is a list of the materials needed for that entire lesson.

Please note that each lesson worksheet includes “The Spark” Intro Video, “Game Time!”, “Character Skit”, “Call To Action”, “Rewind”, and the other lesson segments we provide with the curriculum. Many of the segments included have graphic and video elements that are included in the Data Files folders. There are some segments that require other outside materials that are not included in the curriculum.

The remainder of each lesson is a script to follow for the Opening and Closing Sessions. Feel free to follow it closely or change it up to fit your needs.

LEADER’S INFO

God is the ultimate Creator - the Master Artist of the universe. From the very beginning, He spoke, and everything came into existence. Every part of creation reflects His power, wisdom, and creativity. Nothing happened by chance - God had a perfect plan, shaping the world with purpose and beauty.

In this lesson, children will learn the world around them is not just a collection of random things but a masterpiece created by God. The colors of a sunset, the pattern on a butterfly’s wings, the sound of ocean waves - all of it was designed by Him. A great artist doesn’t rush through a painting or sculpture but carefully crafts each detail. In the same way, God took His time to create a world that works together in harmony.



The “Small Group Experience”

We have included an entire “Small Group Experience” in this Big Event Experience. This is an added bonus that you may choose to use to help reinforce the lesson that was learned in the “Large Group Experience.” These Small Group Experiences were written for three separate age groups (Preschool-1st Grade, 2nd-3rd Grade, and 4th-5th grade).

The Small Group Experiences do require some preparation for each group leader. Please read ahead to make sure that any props, tools, etc. are gathered ahead of time. Our suggestion is to divide the children into small groups (2-10 children works best), according to ages.

Each Small Group Experience is designed to last 30-45 minutes. Feel free to modify any segment to fit your time frame and/or group needs.

Director's Event Timeline

6 Months Before the Event:

- Choose the date, time, and location of the event
- Advertise the event and encourage people to save the date
- Determine the budget for the event
- Figure out how much space you'll need, and make sure the church calendar has availability
- Begin recruiting volunteer team leaders

3 Months Before the Event:

- Decide on the decorations for the event
- Continue recruiting volunteers
- Work with the volunteer team leaders to make sure they have what they need
- Send manuals to team members so they can begin preparing

2 Months Before the Event:

- Hold a volunteer meeting
- Display promotional items for the event
- Purchase supplies

1 Month Before the Event:

- Advertise the event around town
- Send vocalists the songs
- Hold pre-registration for the event

2 Weeks Before the Event:

- Give all volunteers any updates and the final schedule for the event week
- Advertise the event in the church bulletin
- Assign children to teams
- Go over the Large Group elements with the tech team

Director's Event Timeline (Cont.)

1 Week Before the Event:

- Send out a reminder email to team members and parents
- Go over the Large Group elements with the tech team
- Have a full rehearsal with the team (skits, tech cues, songs, etc).

3 Days Before the Event:

- Set up the stage for the event
- Set up the decorations in the environment
- Purchase non-perishable snack items

1 Day Before the Event:

- Set up the registration area
- Set up the activity and rotation station spaces
- Send the final email to leaders reminding them of the first day details, arrival times, etc.
